

PARKING LOT & COMMONS

Reconstructing the Parking Lot and Creating the Parish Commons - \$ 2M

This is a conceptual drawing. Any design will need to be approved by the Village of Glenview

Parking Lot:

- Remove and replace all asphalt to ensure a smooth, pot hole-free surface for years to come.
- Paint parking spaces to improve vehicle traffic flow.
- Construct storm water collection system to prevent harmful run-off into the river.
- Plant trees and other greenery to beautify the lot.
- Install additional lighting, especially along the river, to improve safety and security.

Pedestrian Canopy & Campus Signage:

- Include a campus directory to establish OLPH as a welcoming campus.
- Assist visitors and parishioners in finding their destination with proper signage.
- Provide a visual cue across the parking lot with Pedestrian Canopy.
- Improve safety at pick-up and drop-off with a covered and lighted waiting area.

Enhanced Walkway to South Entrance of Church:

- Beautify the walkway to enhance the transition from parking lot to worship space.
- Plant landscaping and greenery to improve the walkway.
- Hang liturgical artwork (Marian images) along the walkway to enhance aesthetics.
- Convey a deeper sense of hospitality to visitors and new parishioners.

Other Improvements:

- Add handicapped and general parking along Church Street.
- Enhance play areas, making them more secure.
- Soften hard surfaces between buildings by adding greenery and replacing asphalt.
- Include permanent tent anchoring openings in the parking lot surface for outdoor events such as the Block Party and Neighbors Helping Neighbors.
