The Archdiocese of Chicago requires all religious education programs to incorporate Safe Environment education into their programs. We at Our Lady of Perpetual Help are committed to your child's safety and are adhering to this by adding Child Lures® Prevention Safe Environment Education to our curriculum. This short, one-time annual program involves age appropriate education about the possible luring techniques used by potential predators.

Before this program is presented to the children in the Religious Education Program, parents are invited to view the material at the times listed below:

This short media presentation will be held in the Lafayette Building/Francis Room. If after viewing the material to be presented, you decide that you would not like your child to participate in the brief discussion about Child Lures, you will be able to sign a declination form. Your child will then be removed from the presentation they have been assigned to.

Listed on the back side of this letter is the schedule of presentations. You as parents are encouraged to attend to help facilitate any questions your child might have at the conclusion of the presentation or for aiding you in further conversation at home. These presentations with the children will be held in the Playdium.

Also enclosed with this letter, you will find the Parent Guide – a handbook to the Child Lures Prevention Program. I urge you and your children to study the material provided in this handbook. Keep this handbook in a safe place for reference as you child's awareness grows and they are able to understand things a different level. (*We are only able to give one handbook per each family*).
