### Attend the Virtual Celebration of Mundelein



# OLPH profile

As all parishioners know, our Music Ministry is second to none, and for that we can thank our amazing Director of Music Ministry, **Russell Stern**. Russell does so much to bring beauty to our services, even during the pandemic. In this *Parish Profile*, you will learn not only about his background and what he has been doing through this crisis, but also a preview of the amazing things he is planning for the 2020-21 concert Season.

**OLPH** Please tell us a little bit about your background and how long you have been a part of OLPH.

**Russell Stern (RS)** I am beginning my 13th year as Music Director at OLPH. What's interesting is that the first time that I played in a Catholic Church, was in 1984, when I was the organist for the 11:00 AM Choir at OLPH, for 4 months, while their 90 year old organist healed from having fallen out of a tree. I loved being a part of the Music Ministry then, so as soon as my 4 month period was complete, I started my first position as a Music Director in Highland Park. I have loved being a Music Director for Catholic Churches ever since.

**OLPH** Can you tell us what your responsibilities are here at OLPH?

**RS** As Music Director, I plan all of the music and prepare and direct the Children's Choir, the Teen Ensemble, the Adult Festival Choir, the Schola, the 11:00 Ensemble and the Cantors to lead the music at our liturgical celebrations. I also conduct from the piano and the organ, as well as prepare other musicians and singers for our liturgies. As a composer I have written liturgical music that we use at Mass and create many piano improvisations for contemplative moments. Also, I have built a concert series that has been an opportunity for our musicians and guest musicians to perform many styles of music at a high level.

**OLPH** What is the best part of your job?

**RS** As we strive to create the most loving, inspiring music, I find that it is important to create an environment of support, encouragement and fun. One of the best parts of my job is working with people as a team as we, together, learn more and more challenging and rewarding music, and then share the joy of giving our best with our whole hearts to God and the entire congregation.

**OLPH** What advice do you have for your music students and choir members to keep their musical skills sharp during the pandemic?

**RS** We have had periodic Zoom rehearsals which have been one way for the singers to sing along with me directing from the piano. But that hasn't been enough. I also send out the current music lists for the Masses that we have been streaming on Sunday's, so people can sing along. And we are just starting virtual worship aides, which will help with this. I would also suggest doing some of the vocal warm ups that we have done, singing through what songs they can, and singing along with their favorite music on youtube (or whatever source they may have for music).



**OLPH** What are some of your favorite songs to perform?

**RS** I like the deep expressive choral pieces and the super exciting energetic pieces that allow for fun instrumental improvisation at the end of Mass. A few years ago we started adding the repertoire of Dan Forrest who now is my favorite. I love his Easter piece called *And Can It Be*, and his Christmas Song, *See Amid The Winter's Snow*. I also love the music of John Rutter, of which we sing many pieces.

**OLPH** Please tell us an interesting fact about yourself.

**RS** In 1998 I got to play on the organ at St. Peter's (at the Vatican) for a Mass sung by the Chicago Children's Choir and was offered a position there (but we weren't ready to move to Italy). And in 2001, on another tour with the CCC to Great Britain, we premiered a composition that I wrote called *Upon Westminster's Bridge*.

**OLPH** When the quarantine ends, how will you celebrate?

**RS** The biggest celebration will be when I can perform for in-person audiences. Speaking of which, I would like to mention that we have planned our 2020-21 Concert Season as if we are going to be able to have audiences again, though, we will turn these into virtual performances if necessary. I am grateful that again, the concerts will be sponsored by Guild 22! The dates are:

- Sun., Nov. 15, 2020, 3 PM - Theatre Concert 3 (makeup for last year's canceled concert during quarantine)
- Sun., Mar. 7, 2021, 3 PM - Rutter Requiem sung by the Festival Choir and an Instrumental ensemble
- Sunday, May 2, 2020, 3 PM- The Compositions of Russell Stern (makeup for last year's canceled concert during quarantine)

## Technology Update

### Transitioning from pre-recorded to livestreamed Mass

Over the last couple of weeks, under the Reopening plan that we have received from the Archdiocese, we begun to celebrate Mass in our church with a limited number of parishioners in attendance. With this change, we have transitioned from pre-recorded Masses to livestreamed Masses. This transition has resulted in changes in the way we present the Mass online and that has led to some issues for parishioners in their ability to find the Masses.

Prior to the limited Reopening in June, we pre-recorded the online Masses. They could be viewed from the "Featured Mass" playlist on our YouTube Channel at any time after 6:30 am. The following day the Mass (and the Homily) would be transferred to the "Archived Mass" and "Archived Homily" playlists respectively.

Now that we are livestreaming Mass, the way to view Mass is a little bit different. We livestream one Mass per day. The livestream starts about 15 minutes before Mass time. The 8:30 am weekday Masses normally go live around 8:15 am. The Sunday 9:30 Mass goes live around 9:15. The link to the livestream is sent out in every eblast and it is on the homepage of our website. After the Mass has ended and as soon as we are able, we make the Mass available on the "Featured Mass" playlist. Then, as before, it is available for viewing the next day and thereafter from the "Archived Masses" playlist.

Starting on July 4 and continuing each Saturday at 5:00 pm throughout the rest of the summer, we will celebrate a "drive-in" Mass. Parishioners who register via Sign-Up Genius can attend Mass in their car and listen to the service on their car radio. Communion will be delivered to each car by our priest and deacons as they walk throughout the parking lot. We were not able to effectively broadcast the outdoor Mass on YouTube on July 4. We are working on the technology to make a video broadcast available for the upcoming Masses. Right now, however, only the radio audio broadcast is available to those cars in attendance.

We appreciate your understanding, patience, and support, as we are striving for continuous improvement in the ways we utilize technology to bring the Mass to you. Our goal is to maintain and, in fact, grow our spiritual community even during these times of pandemic.

## Fall Religious Education Registration is now open! Register today!



### Religious Education Registration for the fall of 2020 is here!

With the Covid pandemic, our first priority at OLPH is the health and safety of everyone. OLPH Religious Education will follow public health, government and Archdiocesan recommendations and protocols. We will be social distancing, temperatures will be taken before entering the buildings and each classroom will be completely disinfected before and after each session. Masks are encouraged. Please contact us with concerns.

### Three new class days

In order to limit the number of students in each class and on the campus at the same time, we offer three additional class days this year. When we know numbers and what families prefer, we will assign classes. (If we do not have enough students for a particular day or time, a second choice may be necessary.) The new Sunday class, between Masses is only 50 minutes long. Those attending Sunday morning classes will meet 30 times instead of 24 and attend a special event each semester.

### Appeal for Catechists

With smaller classes and three new days of class, we are in great need for Catechists. Times are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday afternoon (4:30-6:00), Tuesday evening (6:30-8:00), Saturday morning (9:00-10:30) Sunday morning (8:40-9:30) and one Friday evening and Sunday per month for the Gather and Grow program. All grade levels needed. Have your own class or be a team teacher. Young and old welcome to volunteer.

### Additional Options for traditional in classroom sessions

Options other than the traditional classroom 24 session classes are Gather and Grow (a family program involving parents and children), e-learning, and Home Schooling. Gather and Grow has its own curriculum. With e-learning and Home Schooling, the curriculum would be the same as the traditional classroom program. Children signed up for e-learning and Home Schooling would be expected to join other students for two activities per semester.

Seventh and Eighth graders are not eligible for e-learning or Home School options as they are preparing for Confirmation and part of the dynamic is sharing the process with their classmates.

### Fees remain the same this year

Fees for Religious Education are the same as last year. A limited number of scholarships are available. **Ability to pay should NEVER keep you from enrolling your family in any of the programs.** Please contact the Rel. Ed. Office to discuss scholarships, payment plans and financial issues. We will work something out.




