Dear Parishioners,

“An attentive ear is the joy of the wise”

This passage from the first reading is from the book of Sirach. It speaks volumes to us in an age overwhelmed by noise. The voices we really need to listen to and take to heart are so easily drowned out. Most talk shows feature people sitting around a table shouting at each other.

We are often quick to respond, to attack those we disagree with, to defend our point of view. We do not engage in thoughtful listening. We do not take the time to reflect on where the other person is coming from.

Some years ago, when the new edition of the Roman Missal was promulgated, it called for more silence in the liturgy, especially after the scriptures are proclaimed. Listening attentively will as Sirach suggests lead us to wisdom.

People who I have discovered in my life that are wise are all great listeners. They listen, they reflect, they clarify before responding. In this world often held captive by vitriol, we would be so better served if we took notice of Sirach's plea to listen attentively!

I am delighted to welcome **Fr. Dennis Kasule** who is from the Archdiocese of Kampala in Uganda and will be leading our mission appeal this weekend. Fr Dennis currently serves on the faculty of Mundelein Seminary. We have been blessed by priests from Uganda here at OLPH starting with **Fr. Patrick Kizza** and **Fr. 
the Silver Rose of Our Lady Guadalupe. The Silver Rose been on pilgrimage since 1960 going all over the world

## Music Ministry

### Instrumentalists and Singers of All Ages Needed

Anytime is a great time to join one of the choirs and help continue to build the Music Ministry at OLPH. This is a wonderful opportunity to serve God and the Parish through sharing your gifts of music and song. And it promises to be a lot of fun as well! The following groups are all directed by our Music Director, **Russell Stern**. New members are always welcome and encouraged to join throughout the year.



### The Adult Festival Choir

- We sing at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday (and sometimes other Masses) until the first week of June. We also sing for Holidays and special occasions. All singers are welcome.
- Rehearses on Tuesday evenings from 7:45-9:15pm in the church. The first rehearsal is on September 13.

### The 10:30 Mass Ensemble

- Sings at the 10:30 AM Mass throughout the year.
- All singers are welcome and instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- The singers rehearse Tuesdays from 7:45-9:15pm in the music office. The first rehearsal is on September 13.
- Instrumentalists rehearse prior to the Mass or as needed.

### The Teen/Young Adult Ensemble

- Sings approx. once a month usually at the Sunday 10:30am Mass, and for Christmas, Easter and other occasions, until early June.
- Students grade 8 through young adult are welcome.
- No audition required for singers. Instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- Rehearses on Tuesdays, starting September 20 from 7:00-7:30pm. in the church

### The Children's/Middle School Choir

- Sings once a month, usually at the 9:00am Mass from October through Mothers Day. They also sing at the Christmas Eve 3:00pm Mass, and on Easter.
- 1st thru 7th grade children are welcome.
- Rehearses on Tuesdays, starting, September 20, from 6:00-6:45pm in the church

### Cantors

- Cantors are auditioned from the choir and are then trained. They are scheduled to sing for 1-3 Masses a month depending upon the church's need and the cantor's availability. A Schola Cantorum made up of our cantors sings periodically at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass.

# Ask Angela

Everything you wanted to know about R. E. (*but were afraid to ask*).

Each week, in the summer Bulletins, our Director of Religious Education & Youth Ministry, **Angela Romero** will answer questions and help parish families understand the benefits and importance of our Religious Education program here at OLPH.

## Why should I enroll my child in Religious Education if they won't receive a sacrament this year?

Religious Education is so much more than sacramental preparation! Parents and the parish collaborate as disciples in the sacred mission of sharing our faith with our children and transmitting our faith to the next generation. In faith and Christian friendship, we create a faith-filled environment in which children will grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church. This growth in faith is something that we, as Catholics, strive for throughout our lives and the Religious Education program is one opportunity for your children to continue to grow their faith.

It is vital for our young people to know Christ and feel a connection to our larger Catholic community. This doesn't

happen overnight and isn't something that has an opportunity to build if we simply show up to Church once a year and when it is time for a Sacrament. In order for our children to have the opportunity to develop a faith of their own, they have to learn and know the faith that is so important to us as adult Catholics. Religious Education allows children to learn about their faith in a community of other young Catholics. This opportunity to grow in faith is one of the biggest gifts we can give to our children.

This year's weekly classes will begin after Labor Day, and Family Catechesis will meet for the first time this year on Saturday, October 1st. We are excited to see all of our students and families back in person on campus this year!





The Archdiocese of Kampala was established on March 25, 1953. It is the most populous diocese in Uganda. It is an area rich in Catholic faith and practice.

The total number of Catholics is 1.9 million which is about 41% of the area's population. They assemble for worship in 70 parishes and 443 missions.

As those statistics indicate, there is a great need to build parishes to serve the spiritual and pastoral needs of Catholics in the area.

Besides, a lot of the area's population faces endemic poverty. The Archdiocese runs numerous schools, medical clinics, and social services aimed at the most vulnerable demographics.



### Discover the Beauty, the Riches, and the Profound Meaning of the Mass at OLPH!





### **Weekly Support Group For Contemplative, Centering Prayer.**

In the Christian tradition contemplative prayer is considered to be pure gift of God. 
