Dear Parishioners,

"Bear with one another, forgive one another."

Happy New Year!

The glorious days of the Christmas Season are filled with so much wonder and joy. The birth of Jesus Christ invites us to rejoice in the impossible becoming possible. The long-awaited Messiah is Emmanuel, God with us.

This weekend is The Feast of the

Holy Family and the last weekend of 2023. This time of year, invites us to recall the blessings and challenges of the past and to be encouraged by the possibilities the new year presents.

Family life is an essential part of who we are. This can be both a blessing and a challenge depending on our circumstances. Each year I look forward to the proclamation of the second reading taken from the Letter of St. Paul to the Colossians. It is a manifesto on how to ground our families on the gospel of love. I would invite you to take the time this week to reflect on the challenges it calls us to embrace. If these couple of verses were truly taken to heart, family life as we know it would be transformed. How many families have been shattered because of the inability to forgive, to express compassion, to be patient or kind?

There are many pressures on family life, financial challenges, conflicts, different expectations, and human frailty. We must work hard to keep it together.

St. Paul is inviting us to reflect on the reality that we are blessed. With this awareness we can face whatever comes our way. We are, as the saying goes better, together.

The holidays can intensify divisions or brokenness in our families. There are not simple solutions to complicated circumstances, but as St. Paul teaches, "do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus." As the Irish poet, Thomas Moore once penned, "earth has no sorrow that heaven cannot heal." We can bring to the Lord any burdens we carry to receive his healing love.

Recently **Pope Francis** issued a statement called "Fiducia Supplicans" in which he reflects on the power and tradition we have of being blessed. There are forms

of blessings we see throughout the Scriptures which are poured out on others as a gesture of grace, protection, and goodness." We have all been created in the image of God. There are many who are in unions which may not be sacramental, but yearn to be blessed, enriched, healed, and be elevated by the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Pope Francis often invokes the mission of our Church with the acclamation, "Todos, Todos, Todos! Everyone! Come! Be blessed by the Lord.

This papal declaration marks a significant evolution of the Church's outreach and understanding of the LGBTQ+ community. We need to continue to walk together as we understand together God's plan and desire for us.

As we begin this New Year, we celebrate this Feast of the Holy Family, I extend a special invitation to anyone who seeks God's blessings, no matter what your circumstances are to avail yourself to the power of God's unconditional love. For same sex couples, for those who feel in any way disconnected from the community of faith, you are blessed! If you would like to receive a special blessing, please contact me. We can never have too many blessings. I want to be there for you!

The celebrations that surround Christmas are so uplifting. Thank you to everyone who makes our observance of the Christmas Season so blessed. From the beauty of our church, the magnificent children's pageant last week, to the glorious music, we are blessed! I just love seeing so many of our college students home for the holidays and the many neighbors and friends of OLPH here for our celebrations.

The oldest blessing in the scriptures venerated by both the Jewish and Christian communities is the blessing of Aaron recorded in the Book of Numbers:

May the Lord bless you and keep you;

May the Lord make his face shine upon you and be gracious unto you;

May the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.

May the New Year be filled with many blessings and graces!







The event will start with coffee and light refreshments at 9:00am and then a welcome by **Fr. Jim Barrett**. There will be a Q&A session following the talk.






