Dear Parishioners,

"Come and you will see."

The early weeks of the New Year are filled with a lot of expectations regarding the possibilities that lie ahead. As we return to the normal patterns of life, hopefully we have been able to recharge our "batteries" and feel energized to begin anew.

The Gospel tells of the calling of the first two apostles, Peter and Andrew. During the ordinary events of a typical day, the Lord enters their lives and invites them to "Come and see." Most spiritual encounters occur during the ordinary moments, when our eyes, our ears, our hearts are opened to the power of God's presence.

As Christmas decorations come down and a fresh blanket of snow covers the landscape, there is a certain starkness to things. We see the conflict between life and death revealed in the reality of winter. Simple tasks can become more challenging as we deal with snow, ice, and the cold. Things that are ordinarily obscured become more obvious.

As we begin to move into the heart of winter, we "come and see" what the Lord has in store for us. Where are areas of my personal life that yearn for God's healing and mercy? Where do I need to leave my comfort zone to keep growing in the ways of the Lord. For some we need to be patient, for others less controlling, for others to be more forgiving.

The encounter of Andrew and Peter with the Lord changed them forever. It caused Andrew to proclaim, "We have found the Messiah!" Andrew was the first called to be an apostle and Peter would become the leader of the twelve and the first leader of the Church after Our Lord ascended into heaven.

As the decorations came down this week in the Church, I felt again a deep sense of gratitude for everyone that it some way contributed to the celebration of Christmas here. The Church was so beautiful, the liturgies so glorious. We are blessed.

Thank you again for your generous and faithful support of the Christmas collection and your ongoing stewardship of the parish. I want to thank our maintenance staff that went above and beyond in assisting in a multitude of set ups and takedowns. It could not have gone better. 



### **Stewardship Report**

#### To all parishioners:

Happy New Year!

There are no words to express our deep gratitude for your generosity to OLPH Parish and its Sunday and Christmas collections as we close out calendar year 2023!

At the completion of six months of our fiscal year, our Parish Community has contributed \$1,727,816 towards General Offertory and Christmas collections. This is an increase of 4.1% over last fiscal year and puts us ahead of our six-month budget by 3.7%. From this figure, \$103,000 is set aside for our First Fruits program which funds our Sharing Parishes and second Collections. These figures also include Bridge the Gap funds of \$173,304 and Christmas donations of \$264,454. As a point of reference, our FY24 annual budget for all collections is \$3.2 million. We pray that the second half of the fiscal year will continue to reflect the increased giving brought about by the generous response to our Intentional Offertory Initiative.

We would also like to report that we have exceeded our 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal goal of \$193,403 by


approximately \$80,000 and want to thank you for your generosity in this area as well. This Annual Appeal helps the Archdiocese, other parishes, and parishioners within the Archdiocese, as well as our own parish community, through the services provided by the Archdiocese to all parishes. Because we have exceeded our goal, OLPH will receive a net rebate of over \$70,000 to use to fund future special projects or needs specific to our parish.

The 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal goal for OLPH is \$200,505, up approximately \$7,000 from 2023. We will hear more about the Appeal and its theme of *Together at the table* over the next few weeks, in preparation for Commitment weekend in mid-February.

As always, without the on-going support of our parish family, we would not be able to maintain the physical aspects of our parish nor sustain the spiritual and liturgical works of our OLPH parish family.

We are ever grateful for all you do to assist in this mission.
