The reopening process

Synod of Bishops

Every year there's an international synod of bishops. Some of the issues raised at the synod will be first raised at the local level. American bishops want to make sure that it's very clear what it is we'll be asking people to talk about and how that feedback will make its way back into the church.

There will be a summer meeting of Catholic bishops. They plan to focus on whether or not they should issue a document on the eucharist. Some bishops want the document to clearly set out standards on when a priest could refuse communion. Others don't and instead feel it should be more of a teaching document on the Eucharist.

Common Mission Between School and Parish

The Archdiocese indicated that it would like to figure out ways to have a common mission between the school and the parish. We may be asked how we can strengthen the common mission.
